*Executive Director Report*

Teresa Bishop presented the Executive Director report (see attached).

**V. Spotlight on Health Department**

Clint Sperber presented an update on the Health Department (attached). He noted the 10 essential public health services.

The Department is currently working on the following:

- Unintentional Injuries –The median cost of an average hospital stay of three days is \$42,970.00.

- Maternal and Child Health – The percent of preterm and low birth weight births in Florida is highest among non-hispanic black infants (two times higher than the rates for non-hispanic white or Hispanic women).
- Teen Zone Return on Investment – The annual cost to run Teen Zone is \$17,000. Admission to a hospital is \$40,000. Having school-based clinics available was discussed but the need is finding licensed volunteers. Mr. Sperber requested Lawnwood Regional Medical Center send a representative to the Teen Health Workgroup.
