## **About the Lincoln Park Advisory Committee**

The LPAC is a subcommittee of the Roundtable of St. Lucie County's Safe Neighborhoods Network. The role of LPAC is:

1. **to provide residents of Lincoln Park a voice** in Roundtable initiatives affecting the Lincoln Park community;
2. **to find creative ways of engaging those residents of Lincoln Park who are not engaged** in the civic life and responsibilities of the community;
3. **to assist the Roundtable in identifying the services and activities that are most needed** in the Lincoln Park area; and
4. **to participate in the implementation of the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention's (OJJDP) Comprehensive Gang Model, known in Fort Pierce as the Restoring the Village Youth Initiative**, a comprehensive program for gang and violence prevention, intervention and suppression that will reduce the incidence of gang related crime, gang membership and violence in and around Lincoln Park.

**The purpose of LPAC is to advocate for positive change in the Lincoln Park community and assist in making Lincoln Park a safe place to reside and work.**

### **Who Can Be a Member of LPAC?**

Membership is open to all individuals who reside or work in Lincoln Park, or otherwise have active and positive ties to the Lincoln Park community.

To be a Voting Member, you must complete the Membership Application by February 1, 2017 and return it to the Roundtable. You must also attend meetings regularly. More than three absences from meetings without prior notice will be cause for removal from the membership roll.
